Minutes for June approved

June 2019 Treasury Report

Rob Cumberland reported that we ended the month of June with a positive cash flow of \$1,357.66. The beginning balance was \$5,726.57, Credits \$1,639.29, Debits \$281.63, Ending Balance \$7,084.23. Of the credits \$1,019.35 was from membership renewals and \$735.20 was from WRR sponsorships. Only \$57.66 of the credits were from WRR registration.

Andy needs email addresses to send messages to WRR volunteers, Dennis and Molly are going to work on getting these and modifying Sign Up Genius to include email addresses.

There is a need for several more volunteers, Dennis will send out a request that members sign up. We particularly need SAG riders and afternoon workers at Cicott. We will check if Peoples Brewing volunteers could fill some of these slots.

Andy will remind Hodson's of the need to provide supplies for the SAG wagons. Volunteers need to bring their own pump. Kay needs to restock the first aid kits for the mobile SAGs.

Posters have been distributed locally by Gary, other board members and Melissa. The Lions club has received 12 and several were mailed to bicycle shops in central Indiana.

Kevin Luse has not signed up to stay overnight at Cicott, but plans to be there.

Tech/ website update

Allen has submitted a list of bugs to be fixed. Molly has suggested several options to implement the ride log. She suggests that completing the coding ASAP, transfer names to the new database and then start recording in the new system as of January 1, 2020. This would allow for testing the new systems compatibility with various browsers and operating systems. Allen suggest password protecting the ride mileage submission page.

Molly has spoken with Justin Ankeney about being a Ride with GPS route coordinator. Molly is working to get admin access to RvGPS and admin access to the list serve.
