

**WRCC March Board Meeting**

**Membership update (Lia)**

There are currently 247 members in the club 11 of which are passed due. 24 new members joined the club in 2020. 9 new members have joined the club in 2021. The Board decided not to purge members whose membership has expired from the list serve until after the New Rider Callout. June 1 was set as the target date to purge the list.

Discussion of Virtual Annual Meeting. Attendance at the virtual annual meeting was good, with 36 individual connections, some representing more than one club member.

Discussion of the International Women's Day rides. A mountain bike ride was held at Tippecanoe Amphitheater on Friday evening, March 5. Five road rides were held on Saturday starting at Brokerage Brewery. Molly Cripe Birt led a B ride with 2 rides, Britt Huff led a C ride with 11 riders, Kathy Schroth and Britt Brown led a D ride with 7 riders, and Tracy Richards led an E ride with 15 riders. There were several gravel rides at Cicott Park on Sunday. ■ riders took part.

The New Rider Callout is scheduled for May 22. There will be C, D, E, and F rides. The target audience of NRC is not experienced riders but riders new to the sport or those who have not ridden with a group. A and B riders are encouraged to join other rides to help make new riders feel welcome. Posters for NRC and Wabash River Ride have been printed.

Posting rides and mileage. Gary discussed the need for rides to be posted on the calendar by the time of NRC so there will be rides for potential club members. The board discussed ride categories. An email will be sent to membership encouraging people to post rides and reminding them of categories and how to submit mileage on the new database.

Future Board meetings will continue to be held on the second Tuesday of the month. During the months of Daylight Savings Time, April-October, meetings will be held at 8pm. The next meeting will be virtual on Tuesday, April 13 at 8pm.
